- Bring casual clothes for day wear, smart casual options for the public lounges and restaurants and don't forget something smart for cruise elegant dinners plus your outfit for our 80s Rock 'n' Glow Deck Party.
- Take some low-denomination Aussie notes, \$5/\$10 are ideal, for the market stalls on some of the islands. Additionally, ATM facilities are available on board.
