## RESERVATIONS

Accommodations are limited. If you use a travel agent/travel agency (“TA”) to book your reservation, you shall pay deposits and payments for Holland America Line’s (“HAL”) services to such TA. HAL will issue travel documents only if and when it has received full payment from TA. HAL will make any refunds to the applicable TA based only on the amount HAL actually received, less any applicable cancellation fees and charges; guest is responsible for obtaining any refund monies from TA.

## DEPOSIT & FINAL PAYMENT REQUIREMENTS

Deposit is required at the time of cruise booking and final payment of balance must be received no later than 90 days prior to departure.

## CANCELLATIONS
